## TERMS & CONDITIONS

The components used in the system must be new, unused, supplied by Wadsworth Limited and designated as 'Quantum' system products.

The components must be installed in accordance with instructions supplied by Wadsworth Limited and International Standard ISO 11801 1.2 (2000-1)

Under the terms of the Warranty, all system warranty requests must be accompanied by a full set of test results carried out using a level III tester, implementing the ISO 11801 1.2 (2000-1) Class D, Permanent Link method. Test results containing failures or marginal passes will invalidate the Warranty for the appropriate circuits.

Wadsworth Electronics Limited hereby confirms the performance of the system within the specification of ISO 11801 1.2 (2000-1) Class D and Class E (Cat 6), Permanent Link (2 connector model).

Unauthorised alterations to the original installation, or to any of the passive components used within the system, will render the Warranty void. The system test results must be retained by the installer and Wadsworth Limited for the term of the Warranty.

Wadsworth Limited reserves the right to review the 'Quantum' Warranty Terms in the event of any significant alteration to the operating environment in which the total system was originally installed.

Any alteration, which must be approved in writing by Wadsworth Limited, to the original installation or any change in ownership of the installation, must be subject to re-certification for the remainder of the Term. Under the Terms of the Warranty the workmanship and labour are the sole responsibility of the installer.

Wadsworth Limited reserves the right to refuse certification of any system not conforming to the original design specification. Wadsworth Limited shall not be held responsible for any consequential loss whatsoever, in the event of failure of the whole or any part of the system or any component there in.

In the event of any component failure, Wadsworth Limited reserves the right either to repair or to replace such faulty component. The original system certificate and any subsequent certificate must be retained by the user and by Wadsworth Limited for the term of the Warranty.

The Warranty must be read in conjunction with the standard Terms and Conditions of sale of Wadsworth Limited and is to be regarded as an extension thereof. In the event of any conflict between the Terms of this Warranty and the standard Terms and Conditions of Wadsworth Limited, the former shall prevail.
